PE

This term we will be doing gymnastics focusing on different types of balancing. The children will also be looking at improving their footwork and balance and jumping and landing skills.

Science

In this term, our focus is 'Animals, including Humans'.

We will be looking at the digestive system in humans, the different types of teeth in humans and their functions, different food chains and identifying producers, predators and prey.

Music

This term we will be focusing on the use of singing. We will be thinking about the pitch of our voice, singing in rounds and evaluating other singing.


We will also be learning about Classical music and analysing music by Beethoven and Mozart.

Maths

Our main focus for maths in the term will be multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions and decimals.

RE / SMSC
